Export Control Reform & Role of the Dept. of Defense – DoD Update from DTSA**

NAITA invites you to attend the next **Export Controls Roundtable** session focusing on the Department of Defense's role in the Presidentially-directed Export Control Reform. In August 2009, the President directed a broad-based interagency review of the U.S. export control system, with the goal of strengthening national security and the competitiveness of key U.S. manufacturing and technology sectors by focusing on current threats, as well as adapting to the changing economic and technological landscape.

Our guest speaker, **Mr. Anthony Aldwell, Deputy Director of the Defense Technology Security Administration (DTSA)** will provide DoD perspective on USG efforts to fundamentally reform the U.S. export control system and what this means for industry, including the complex issues involved in DTSA's national security review for munitions licenses from the Department of State and dual-use licenses from the Department of Commerce. DTSA administers the development and implementation of DoD technology security policies on international transfers of defense-related goods, services and technologies. It ensures that critical U.S. military technological advantages are preserved; transfers that could prove detrimental to U.S. security interests are controlled and limited; proliferation of weapons of mass destruction and their means of delivery is prevented; diversion of defense-related goods to terrorists is prevented; military interoperability with foreign allies and friends is supported; and the health of the U.S. defense industrial base is assured.

Mr. Aldwell, a member of the Senior Executive Service, assumed these duties as Deputy Director of DTSA in October 2008. In this capacity, he manages a staff of 220 policy analysts, engineers, and licensing officers responsible for developing and implementing DoD technology security policies for international transfers of defense-related goods, services, and technologies.

Prior to becoming Deputy Director of DTSA, Mr. Aldwell served as the Principal Director for European and NATO Policy in the Office of the Secretary of Defense. He previously served as the Director for NATO Policy and the Director for Southern European Policy. Prior to joining the Civil Service, Mr. Aldwell was a Senior Policy Analyst for Science Applications International Corporation (SAIC), where he served as the primary Staff Assistant to Assistant Secretary Crouch for the development of NATO's new Command Structure.
