



Export Controls & Compliance Roundtable Discussion: **COMMERCIAL ENCRYPTION EXPORT CONTROLS**

Export and reexport controls on commercial encryption products are administered by the Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) of the U.S. Department of Commerce. Rules governing exports and reexports of encryption items are found in the Export Administration Regulations (EAR). U.S. encryption export policy rests on three principles: review of encryption products prior to sale, streamlined post-export reporting, and license review of certain exports and reexports of strong encryption to foreign governments. In December 2004, the EAR were amended to streamline and strengthen export and reexport controls on encryption items, in keeping with these principles.

This roundtable will focus on the unique provisions related to encryption under the EAR. Topics to be discussed include how items with encryption functionality are classified under the EAR; how the provision for >64-bit "mass market" encryption may apply to products that you use, sell or buy; license exception provisions for encryption source code (open source and proprietary); license exception provisions for U.S. subsidiaries, encryption notification, review and reporting requirements; Encryption Licensing Arrangements; conditions placed on encryption licenses, and other encryption technology issues.

Discussion will be lead by Michele Futch, Sr. Staff Administrator with Intergraph Corporation. Michele holds a CIS degree and has been with Intergraph for 23 years. Among many responsibilities, Michele liaisons with software program developers and the export compliance department to identify products containing encryption capabilities. Michele recently participated in a Bureau of Industry & Security (BIS) Encryption Export Controls Seminar held in Washington, DC, and she will share updates from that meeting.
