As a result of the World Customs Organization's recently proposed changes to the international *Harmonized System*, the U.S. is set to implement sweeping changes to the *Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States*. The updated Harmonized Tariff, taking effect on February 3 of 2007, will see amendments to 83 of its 97 chapters and 240 headings. The chapters most affected by these changes are those dealing with industrial and technology related products.
