U.S. Harmonized System: 2007 Tariff Changes & Rules of Classification

As a result of the World Customs Organization's recently proposed changes to the international Harmonized System, the U.S. is set to implement sweeping changes to the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States. The updated Harmonized Tariff, taking effect on February 3, 2007, will see amendments to 83 of its 97 chapters and 240 headings. The chapters most affected by these changes are those dealing with industrial and technology-related products. Due to the scope of these changes, we are beginning our 2007 seminar schedule by giving an overview of the changes to the Harmonized Tariff and how they will affect importers and exporters, as well as a review of methods of classification and the Rules of Interpretation.

NAITA and TEAM Worldwide present a full day seminar on the ***U.S. Harmonized Tariff*** - an overview of the proposed changes for the first quarter of 2007 to both the Harmonized Tariff and Schedule B systems, and a look at how they will impact both importers and exporters.
