About the International Services Council: funded by Madison County, the City of Huntsville, and the U.S. Department of State, the International Services Council is affiliated with the US Department of State through the National Council for International Visitors [NCIV]. Since 1965, ISC has welcomed international military trainees at the Arsenal; coordinated multi-cultural events in the Huntsville area; helped area residents obtain information about immigration and naturalization services; and hosted visitors sent to Alabama by the U.S. Department of State under the auspices of the International Visitor Leadership Program [IVLP], now ISC's main focus.

U.S. Department of State visitors who come under the auspices of the International Visitor Leadership Program stay in the US for about 3 weeks, spend time in Washington, then have an opportunity to meet with professionals in their fields of interest in various cities throughout the US. IVLP participants are recommended for this kind of experience by US embassies around the world.
